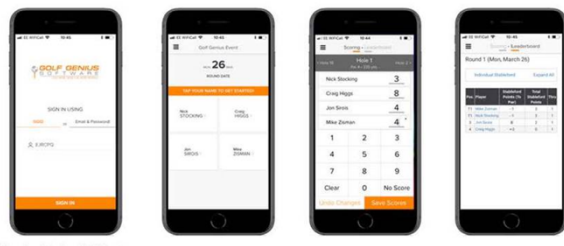

Please download the Golf Genius App before arriving, it will make the scoring process easier!

1. Download the free "Golf Genius" app from the app store. Log in using your GGID located in the bottom right-hand corner of your scorecard.
2. Only 1 person in each group needs to do the live scoring - select your name.
3. Enter your scores. Golf Genius will work out your adjusted team score to account for handicaps.
4. Stay up to date with the live leaderboard!
